Return of Entry Forms

Completed final entry forms together with appropriate fees should be returned to WheelPower no later than **Friday 6th September 2019**.

Arrival/Departure

Teams/individuals may register from 12pm onwards at Stoke Mandeville Stadium on Monday 30th September. The first official meal will be lunch on the 30th September. The Games will begin at 2pm. The last official meal will be lunch on Thursday 4th October. Presentations will take place before lunch.

Eligibility to enter

Participants should be aged 11-18 years on the 31st August 2019. Please see general rules for further information.

Entry fees

- The entry fee is at a reduced rate of £75 per person (this includes accommodation and all meals).
- The entry fee for non-residents will be £37.50 per person.
- Please note this entry fee is applicable to all individuals attending the Games including parents/teachers/guardians/carers (for example, if a participant and carer attended it would be £150).
- **The Entry Fee must be paid in full by 6th September 2019. Any groups attending who require an invoice please contact WheelPower Finance before 6th September 2019. Payments not received by 6th September 2019 may result in your places being allocated to other groups.**

Medals

There will be individual certificates for sports and every competitor will receive a commemorative medal.

General rules for the National Junior Games

1. General

The Games are open to any child and young person with a physical disability or sensory impairment. Included within this general definition are also those young people with a disability or dysfunction which is difficult to measure or grade in the traditional sense of disability sports classification. This would particularly include any dyspraxic (aka clumsy) young people, those with epilepsy or some form of internal organ dysfunction or absence. The aim of this broader definition is to make some form of provision for those young people who are unable to “fit in” to mainstream PE/sports provision but who also do not qualify for disability provision.

If you are uncertain as to whether a child or young person qualifies please contact WheelPower.

2. Age Groups

There will be four age groups used in some sports where there are enough competitors to make separate events appropriate. Otherwise age groups will be combined (see sport specific guidelines).

The age groups are as follows:

- Group A: 11-12
- Group B: 13-14
- Group C: 15-16
- Group D: 17-18

3. The Games

The National Junior Games are a mixture of have-a-go and friendly competitions in a variety of sports. At sports where competition takes place within the programme, staff aim to use an informal classification system where possible, however due to the inclusive eligibility and number that attend the event it is difficult to operate a full classification system. Therefore, this may result in a range of abilities within the competitions.

The accommodation at Stoke Mandeville Stadium is located at the Olympic Lodge Hotel and Olympic Village within the grounds of the stadium and is only a short distance to all the sports facilities. Participants and staff/escorts will either be housed in the twin bed Olympic Lodge hotel rooms or the traditional dormitory-style rooms. Due to limited accommodation please be aware that you may be accommodated in either type of accommodation.

4. **Competition and “Have a go” Sports Lists:** Please note a participant can take part in **only 5** out of following 9 competition sports.
